



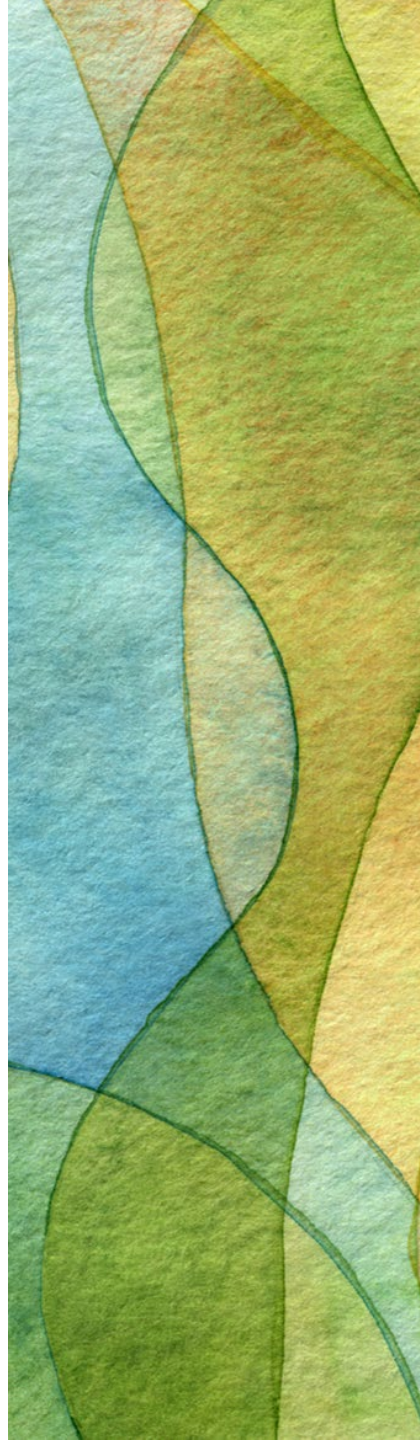

Drawbacks of Current Processes

- Difficult to move data between applications
- Inconsistent version control
- Locating data (personal/shared folders)
- Accessing data if staff leave
- Time it takes to share data with ISPCTN

Piestar Solutions to Issues

- Centralized data repository
 - Version control of data collection tools
 - Automated email reminders
 - Easy to create custom forms & reports
 - Tracks module completion
- **Easier to locate & share non-study data**





Piestar Information

Designed for:

- Projects funded by NIH, NIST, NSF, USAID, USDA
- Meeting agency reporting requirements
- Follow agency policies, compliance, & reporting

Two systems:

- DPx – collect data, manage projects, monitor progress, evaluate impact, & report results from a given grant year
- RFx – request, review, rate, and select proposals

First Access to Piestar

- The email is from Piestar
- Use link to create an account in Piestar
- Locate assigned module(s)
- Complete assigned modules by the deadline
- Know how to get help if you have problems
